

Regulations of the Kids Aquathlon Gdynia event (hereinafter referred to as: "event")

I. ORGANIZER

- 1.1. The organizer of the Event is Sport Evolution Group Sp. z o.o., Jana Kochanowskiego 12/23, 01-864 Warsaw, registered in the District Court for the capital city of Warsaw, XIII Wydział Gospodarczy Krajowego Rejestru Sądowego, KRS 0000779253, NIP: 1231431002, REGON: 382960037, **address for correspondence ul. Janki, ul. Falencka 1B, 05-090 Raszyn**, (hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer").

II. DEFINITIONS

- 2.1. **Organizer** - the entity responsible for organising the event;
- 2.2. **Athlete** - a legal person who has registered for the Event by completing the registration form and paying the entry fee;
- 2.3. **Entry fee** - the fee that must be paid to register for the event;
- 2.4. **Resignation** - resignation from participation in the event, resignation means deleting the athlete from the list of event participants;
- 2.5. **Event website** - the official website of the event, <http://www.ironmangdynia.pl/>

III. GENERAL RULES

- 3.1. The event shall take place in accordance with the Polish Triathlon Association regulations.
REGULATIONS OF THE POLISH TRIATHLON ASSOCIATION
- 3.2. For the safety of Athletes, Volunteers and the Organizers during the event, all participants and spectators are required to follow the current epidemic guidelines available at www.gov.pl.
- 3.3. Entry to the Event of persons in quarantine, under epidemiological surveillance or showing signs of infection (fever, cough, shortness of breath) is prohibited.
- 3.4. The parent or legal guardian of the Athlete declares that he/she is aware of the degree of risk incurred in terms of COVID - 19 infection during the Event..
- 3.5. In the event that the Event is postponed due to the COVID-19 pandemic or other virus, or for reasons beyond the organiser's control (so-called "force majeure"), the Athlete will automatically be moved to a new Event date. The Athlete will be automatically transferred to the new date of the Event. The athlete's parent or legal guardian will have the opportunity to apply for a refund of the entry fee paid, within the deadline given by the Organizer.
- 3.6. In the event of cancellation due to the COVID-19 pandemic or other virus, or for reasons beyond the organiser's control (so-called "force majeure"), the Athlete will receive a voucher, of the value of the entry fee paid, to be used at an event held in the IRONMAN series in Poland the following year.
- 3.7. Force majeure within the meaning of these Terms and Conditions is any unforeseeable situation or event of an exceptional nature, beyond the Organizer's control, making it impossible to fulfil any of the obligations provided for in these Terms and Conditions, not resulting from the Organizer's error or negligence and

remaining insurmountable despite the exercise of all due diligence, in particular: natural catastrophe events of the type of flood, hurricane, windstorms of extraordinary force, tornadoes, earthquakes, exceptionally intense and prolonged downpours or extraordinary and external events that could not have been prevented (such as: war, martial law restrictions, state of emergency restrictions, state of calamity restrictions, insurrection, revolution, riots, terrorist attack), epidemic threats, states of epidemic danger, epidemics and states of epidemics, as well as the entry into force of new laws or the issuing of decisions by public administration authorities preventing the Organizer from fulfilling its obligations. Neither the Organizer nor the Competitors shall be liable for failure to perform or improper performance of the provisions of these Rules and Regulations caused by force majeure.

IV. DATE AND PLACE

- 4.1. The event will take place on August 4, 2023 in Gdynia.
- 4.2. The Start and Finish will be located at the City Beach in Gdynia
- 4.3. The start time of the Event will be published in the "Event Schedule" on the event page at a later date.
- 4.4. The organizer reserves the right to change the location of the start and finish line.

V. DISTANCE, ROUTE, TIME LIMIT

- 5.1. The event will take place over the following distances:
 - 5.1.1. Girls and boys 5-7 years: 50 meters swimming and 100 meters running (born in 2018-2016)
 - 5.1.2. Girls and boys 8-9 years: 100 meters swimming and 500 meters running (born in 2015-2014)
 - 5.1.3. Girls and boys 10-11 years: 200 meters swimming and 1000 meters running (born in 2013-2012)
 - 5.1.4. Girls and boys 12-13 years: 200 meters swimming and 1000 meters running (born in 2011-2008)
 - 5.1.5. Girls and boys 14-15 years: 400 meters swimming and 2000 meters running (born in 2009-2008)
- 5.2. Swimming - In the waters of the Bay of Gdansk. Start from the beach shoreline. Expected water temperature in the area: 17-20 °C. The competitors must be equipped with swimming gear (swimming suit, in the water temperature below 20°C it is allowed to swim in triathlon wetsuits). The cap will be provided by the organizer.
- 5.3. The run - on the Seaside Boulevard, concrete surface. Full clothing running is obligatory at the race - it is forbidden to run without a starting number.
- 5.4. The detailed route of the Event will be published on the Event website. The Organizer has the right to change the route and its distance. Such a change shall not give rise to any additional claims and liabilities.
- 5.5. Apart from the Organizer, persons authorized by the Organizer and public services, no person without a start number is allowed on the route. Persons violating this prohibition may be removed from the route by appropriate services.
- 5.6. Electronic timing checkpoints will be located along the route of the Event. Bypassing a control point may result in disqualification.

VI. PARTICIPATION

- 6.1. The Event is open to persons born between 2008 and 2018.
- 6.2. Each athlete must be verified at the Race Office.
- 6.3. Successful verification is conditional upon the personal appearance of the athlete and the athlete's parent or legal guardian and submission to the Event Office of an entry confirmation in the form of a QR ticket.
- 6.4. The QR ticket, necessary for verification at the race office, will be made available to the athlete no later than 3 days before the event to the e-mail address provided during registration.
- 6.5. The cost of the entry fee, accommodation, travel and own meals are covered by the athlete on his own.
- 6.6. For safety reasons it is prohibited to:
 - 6.6.1. Bring onto the route of the Event objects that may constitute a danger to other athletes.
 - 6.6.2. To participate in the event wearing clothing which covers the face and makes it impossible to identify the athlete.
 - 6.6.3. Start with animals.
 - 6.6.4. Start with pushchairs
- 6.7. Each Athlete is required to participate in the Event wearing the cap provided in the entry pack. During the running stage, the Athlete is required to place the starting number on the front of the chest. Failure by the Athlete to comply with this obligation may result in the Athlete being disqualified from the Event.

VII. SAFETY

- 7.1. By stepping on the starting line the athlete acknowledges that he/she is taking part solely under the responsibility of his/her parents or legal guardians and that the parent or legal guardian bears the risk involved, accepting that participation in the Competition involves physical effort and entails natural risks and the danger of accidents, the possibility of personal injury and physical trauma (including death) as well as damages and losses of a property nature and has voluntarily decided to assume these risks. The above does not exclude the Organiser's liability resulting from mandatory legal regulations.
- 7.2. The organizer provides accident insurance to athletes who have been correctly verified in the Race Office. Each athlete will be covered by insurance cover in the field of accident insurance occurring during the insurer's liability period in the territory of the Republic of Poland, consisting in bodily injury or health disorder, causing permanent health impairment or death of the insured. The insurance is paid by the Policyholder, ie the Organizer.
- 7.3. The athletes are obliged to strictly follow the instructions of the Organizers, services responsible for road traffic management, including the Police, Municipal Police, judges and other services securing the route of the event.
- 7.4. The decisions of the medical service regarding the continuation of the race by athletes are final and indisputable. The medical transport of the athlete results in his disqualification.
- 7.5. If an athlete decides to withdraw from the competition at any time during the event, he/she must notify the judges or the organizer.

VIII. REGISTRATION

- 8.1. Applications for the Event shall be accepted through the application form available on SlotMarket.pl.
- 8.2. Applications will be accepted online from October 25, 2022 to July 30, 2023 or until places are filled.
- 8.3. The limit of athletes in the event is 300 people.
- 8.4. If the limit is reached, the Organizer reserves the right to close the registration earlier.
- 8.5. The Organizer reserves the right to invite people to take part in the Event after the limit of places has been reached or after the date given in point 8.2.
- 8.6. The organizer reserves the right to change the limit of places, and everyone who has purchased the package by the date of announcement of such a change has a guaranteed right to start.
- 8.7. The registration is considered when the application form is correctly completed and when the payment the current entry fee available in the event registration profile on SlotMarket.pl
- 8.8. The confirmation of successful registration is:
 - 8.8.1. confirmation of registration for the event from SlotMarket.pl (confirmation from the email address contact@slotmarket.pl);
 - 8.8.2. payment confirmation from DotPay (confirmation from email address transakcje@dotpay.pl);
 - 8.8.3. information about registration in the Registration History on the SlotMarket.pl in user account (status: "Registered").

IX. GROUP REGISTRATION

- 9.1. Group registrations are accepted via the email address faktury@slotmarket.pl.
- 9.2. Payment for group entries is made to the Organizer's bank account on the basis of a Pro-Forma document with a 7-day payment deadline. Pro-Forma document is issued for the start of at least three participants (it is not possible to receive Pro-Forma for the start of a group of up to two people and for individual start).
- 9.3. Group registrations are accepted up to 30 days before closing the registration form.
- 9.4. In order to receive a Pro-Forma document, please send: invoice details and the number of participants to the address faktury@slotmarket.pl.
- 9.5. After making the payment for the Pro-Forma document, registration codes will be sent, reducing the entry fee.
- 9.6. Registration codes are valid for 14 days from the date of receipt of the codes.
- 9.7. People who register using codes are required to fill in the event registration form available on the SlotMarket.pl website and provide the code in the last step of registration.
- 9.8. People who do not register using the code, will not be allowed to take part in the Event.

X. ENTRY FEE

- 10.1. The current entry fee for the Event can be found at www.SloMarket.pl on the Event registration form.

- 10.2. The entry fee should be paid via the DotPay transaction service. All data provided in payments are entered on a secure encrypted page.
- 10.3. The fee must be paid upon registration, otherwise the application will be canceled.
- 10.4. The Entry Fee consists of servicing the athlete before the event (e-mail communication and via Social Media channels), maintaining the servers of the event website, purchases and renting products necessary to organize the event, as well as organizing and promoting the event.
- 10.5. An athlete who wants to receive an invoice for the paid entry fee should select the appropriate option in the registration form and enter the required data needed to issue the document. The invoice will be generated automatically after the payment is credited and will be available for download from the athlete's profile.
- 10.6. The organizer does not issue invoices in paper form.
- 10.7. The invoice may be requested by writing to the address faktury@slotmarket.pl until the end of the event.
- 10.8. Invoices to the individual will be issued up to three months after payment.
- 10.9. Business invoices will be issued by the fifteenth of the month following payment.

XI. STARTING KIT

- 11.1. As part of the event, each athlete receives:
 - 11.1.1. Bib numer
 - 11.1.2. Swimming cap
 - 11.1.3. Wirstband
 - 11.1.4. Chip
- 11.2. Athletes who have completed the event are entitled to get a medal.
- 11.3. The basis to receive the starting kit is scanning the QR code at the Race Office.
- 11.4. Receiving the starting kit means that the volunteer will put on the athlete's wristband.
- 11.5. An athlete who gives the starting kit to another person and a person who purchases the starting kit without notifying the Organizer may be disqualified, as well as suspended from participation in events organized by Sport Evolution Group Sp. z o.o. for 2 years
- 11.6. The location and opening hours of the Race Office are given in point 12.2. The Race Office will be closed on the day of the event.
- 11.7. The athlete is obliged to leave his belongings in the Transition Area before the start.
- 11.8. The starting kits which will not be collected during the working hours of the Race Office may be delivered to the Athlete by courier on his/her request to the following address: gdynia@ironman.com within 7 days from the day of the Event. The cost of delivery is:
 - 11.8.1. 20 PLN – Poland
 - 11.8.2. 10 EUR - European Union countries
 - 11.8.3. 20 EUR- countries outside the European Union
- 11.9. The cost of delivery is paid by the Athlete before delivery.

XII. RACE OFFICE, TRANSITION ZONE, START, FINISH

RACE OFFICE

- 12.1. The race office will be located at Kościuszko Square in Gdynia, August 5-6, 2023.

- 12.2. The race office will be open from 12:00 p.m. - 16:30 p.m. (August 4, 2023)
- 12.3. Each athlete is obliged to pick up his/her starting kit at the Race Office during its opening hours. Starting kits will not be given to another person.
- 12.4. The opening hours of the Race Office and location are possible to change. Such change shall not give rise to any additional claims and liabilities. The exact opening hours of the Race Office and its location will be published on www.ironmangdynia.pl and on www.ironman.com.

START & FINISH

- 12.5. The start and finish line will be located on the city beach in Gdynia.
- 12.6. The start time will be published at www.ironmangdynia.pl.
- 12.7. It is forbidden to run into the finish line with an accompanying person, animal or things which may endanger the safety of the athlete or other people. Failure to comply with this point will result in disqualification.

XIII. WITHDRAWALS & TRANSFERS

- 13.1. It is not possible to transfer an entry fee paid to another year or another event or another person.
- 13.2. Withdrawal from the Event shall be reported by writing to gdynia@ironman.com. The amount of the entry fee refund shall depend on the date of resignation:
 - 13.2.1. until April 4, 2023 we refund: 50% of the entry fee;
 - 13.2.2. from April 5, 2023 until June 20, 2023 we refund: 25% of the entry fee;
 - 13.2.3. from June 21, 2023, the entry fee is not returned.

XIV. CLASSIFICATIONS & PRIZES

- 14.1. The following classifications will be held at the Event:
 - 14.1.1. Boys and girls 5 – 7 years
 - 14.1.2. Boys and girls 8 – 9 years
 - 14.1.3. Boys and girls 10 – 11 years
 - 14.1.4. Boys and girls 12 – 14 years
 - 14.1.5. Boys and girls 14 – 15 years
- 14.2. Classification is determined by the year of birth
- 14.3. The official time of the event is the athlete's gross time.
- 14.4. The results will be announced no later than 15 minutes before the awards ceremony. The results will be on the timing company's website.
- 14.5. The results will be published on the event website and delivered to the media.
- 14.6. In the case of absence from the award ceremony, the prizes can only be collected at the Organizer's office up to 30 days after the end of the event.
- 14.7. Winners of places I-III in the general category of women and men will receive commemorative statuettes.
- 14.8. The organiser reserves the right to introduce additional prizes in the categories of his choice.

XV. PROTECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

- 15.1. Personal data controller of participants is Sport Evolution Group Sp. z o.o., Jana Kochanowskiego street 12/23, 01-864 Warsaw, daneosobowe@sporteolution.pl.

- 15.2. Personal data of participants of Event will be processed for the purposes of organizing and carrying out Event, to select the winner and to award, release, receive the prize and other activities related to the economic activity and will not be shared with other customers.
- 15.3. For the purposes of chip timing and result sheet creation as well as sending one's bib number information and official time, personal data of the athlete (name, last name, year of birth, gender, city, email address, phone number) will be shared with Datasport, ul. Okrężna 22, 58-310 Szczawno Zdrój.
- 15.4. The participant has a right to access his/her data and correct them. Providing personal data and consent to their processing is optional, but necessary to achieve the said objectives. Failure to provide data or lack of consent to their processing prevents participation in the event. Please be advised that your consent may be revoked at any time.
- 15.5. Processing of participants data, in connection with participation in the event, includes publication of name, surname, year of birth, club participant with the name of the town in which he resides - in every way in which the project will be published.
- 15.6. All information concerning participants obtained by the Organizer and included in the registration form will be recorded in electronic way and in each case they will be used pursuant to in accordance with the applicable law.
- 15.7. The organizer reserves the right to carry out interviews with each of the participants, take photos and film them for advertising, promotional purposes, use on the Internet or in radio and TV broadcasts and for other commercial purposes.
- 15.8. The Organizer reserves the right to use, without compensation, all photographs, films, interviews, and voice recordings introducing the Event participants. These materials may be used by the Organizer in the form of CD-ROMs, DVDs, catalogues, internet sites, newspapers, and exhibition stands, as well for promotional-commercial purposes concerning the Events run by the organizers.
- 15.9. The data retention period shall be
 - 15.9.1. For data processed for the purpose of asserting possible legal claims - until the claim is time-barred or the proceedings related to the claim are concluded.
 - 15.9.2. For data processed for the purpose of documenting and communicating activities, not more than 5 years from the date of the documented event, unless the data are processed for archiving purposes in the public interest.
 - 15.9.3. For data processed to ensure the security of networks and information systems - not more than 5 years from the date of registration.
 - 15.9.4. For data processed on the basis of the athlete's agreement - until that agreement is withdrawn.
- 15.10. In order to withdraw your consent to the processing of your personal data, you must complete the application form on <https://slotmarket.pl/document/polityka-prywatnosc> and send it to contact@slotmarket.pl.

XVI. COMPLAINTS

- 16.1. Complaints concerning matters related to the Event shall be submitted in writing with justification to the Organizer's correspondence address, with the note "Kids Aquathlon Gdynia - Complaint", within 7 days from the date of the event - directly or by registered mail (the date of the postmark is decisive) or to the address: gdynia@ironman.com, with the note " Kids Aquathlon Gdynia - Complaint".
- 16.2. Complaints sent after the deadline in point 16.1. will not be considered.
- 16.3. Complaints about race will be considered by Organizer within 60 days of their receipt.
- 16.4. The Organizer's decision on complaints about race will be final.
- 16.5. The above does not limit the Consumer's rights to pursue their claims under mandatory provisions of law before common courts.

XVII. COMPLAINTS PROCEDURE

- 17.1. All Event participants are bound by these Regulations.
- 17.2. The Regulations shall apply from October 25, 2022.
- 17.3. Each participant is obliged to read the regulations.
- 17.4. Ignorance of the Regulations does not release the athlete from the rules specified by the Organizer in these Regulations.
- 17.5. It is forbidden to bring any kind of narcotic, illegal substance, drugs improving athletic performance, as well as alcoholic products to the area encompassing the Event. Participants are prohibited from taking such drugs and substances both before and during the race, failure to abide by this rule may result in exclusion from participation in the Event. If it is found that an athlete violates the above prohibition, the organizer reserves the right not to allow him to participate in the race or exclude him during the race.
- 17.6. No athlete may use performance enhancing drugs or activities. Any doping attempt will be dealt with according to the Polish Triathlon Association's anti-doping rules. Athletes may be required to undergo tests before and after the event. If an athlete is called for a test, he/she is required to attend the test.
- 17.7. Medical control rules are in accordance with the rules and policies of the Polish Triathlon Association rules and apply to all competitors. In addition, if necessary, other regulations, not binding in the rules of the Polish Triathlon Association, may be applied.
- 17.8. On the reverse of the starting number there will be a table that each athlete should fill in for easier identification in the event of an accident. The table includes data concerning any medicines taken, possible allergies and telephone number of a person to be contacted by the Organizer in case of an accident.
- 17.9. The organizer provides emergency medical care along the route and at the finish line.
- 17.10. The organiser shall provide water security (WOPR) during the event in water.
- 17.11. The Organizer is not responsible for lost valuables during the Event.

- 17.12. The organiser reserves the right to cancel or modify the event, stating reasons. In the event that the swimming stage cannot be held (red flag), the swimming stage will be cancelled and a run will be organised.
- 17.13. Binding and final interpretation of these Regulations shall be vested exclusively in the organizer of the Event. Should any of the provisions of the Rules and Regulations be partially or fully modified, all other provisions shall remain valid.
- 17.14. The organizer reserves the right to change the name of the event
- 17.15. In matters not covered by the regulations, the Organizer shall decide on the basis of the applicable law. The above does not limit the right to court in case of a dispute.
