

Regulations of the Sprint Triathlon Gdynia Relay event (hereinafter referred to as: "event")

I. ORGANIZER

- 1.1. The organizer of the Event is Sport Evolution Group Sp. z o.o., Jana Kochanowskiego 12/23, 01-864 Warszawa, registered in the District Court for the capital city of Warsaw, XIII Wydział Gospodarczy Krajowego Rejestru Sądowego, KRS 0000779253, NIP: 1231431002, REGON: 382960037, **address for correspondence ul. Janki, ul. Falencka 1B, 05-090 Raszyn**, (hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer").

II. DEFINITIONS

- 2.1. **Organizer** - the entity responsible for organising the event;
- 2.2. **Athlete** - a legal person who has registered for the Event by completing the registration form and paying the entry fee;
- 2.3. **Entry fee** - the fee that must be paid to register for the event;
- 2.4. **Resignation** - resignation from participation in the event, resignation means deleting the athlete from the list of event participants;
- 2.5. **Transfer** - transferring the entry fee to another athlete, transfer means deleting the athlete from the list of event participants;
- 2.6. **Event website** - the official website of the event, www.ironmangdynia.pl
- 2.7. **Extra Service** - an additional service purchased by the athlete, which is not included in the entry fee.
- 2.8. **Team Captain** - Relay Member; The Athlete who paid the entry fee.
- 2.9. **Team member** – relay member; The Athlete who registered with the token.
- 2.10. **Token** – a special team code.

III. GENERAL RULES

- 3.1. During the Event the rules are in accordance with the Polish Triathlon Federation regulations.

- 3.2. The judges notify athletes of a breach of the Rules & Regulations showing the colorful cards in conjunction with verbal directive.
[Card colors and related penalties.](#)
- 3.3. All time penalties take place in the area marked as the Penalty Tent, failure to serve the penalty will result in disqualification.
- 3.4. Any Athlete who has received another time penalty will be disqualified.
- 3.5. For the safety of Athletes, Volunteers and the Organizers during the event, all participants and spectators are required to follow the current epidemic guidelines available at www.gov.pl.
- 3.6. Entry to the Event of persons in quarantine, under epidemiological surveillance or showing signs of infection (fever, cough, shortness of breath) is prohibited.
- 3.7. The athlete declares that he/she is aware of the degree of risk incurred in terms of COVID - 19 infection during the Event.

- 3.8. The athlete declares that he will not make any claims against the Organizer in the event of being infected with the COVID-19 virus during the event.
- 3.9. In the case of a cancellation due to the COVID-19 pandemic or other virus, or for reasons beyond the Organizer's control (so-called "force majeure"), an athlete will receive a voucher, of the value of the entry fee paid, to be used at an event taking place in the IRONMAN series in Poland the following year.
- 3.10. If the date of the Event is changed due to the COVID-19 pandemic or another virus, or for reasons beyond the Organizer's control (so-called "force majeure"), the competitor will automatically be moved to a new date of the Event. The competitor will have the opportunity to change the entry fee into a voucher within a time period specified by the Organizer. The voucher of the value of the entry fee paid will be available for events in the IRONMAN series in Poland in the following year.
- 3.11. In the event of cancellation or rescheduling of the event due to the COVID-19 pandemic or other virus, as well as for reasons beyond the Organizer's control (so-called "force majeure"), the money for the purchased additional services will be returned to the competitor within 180 days. The insurance and the Polish Triathlon Federation License will not be refunded.
- 3.12. Force majeure in the meaning of these Regulations shall be any and all unforeseeable situations or events of exceptional nature, remaining beyond the Organizer's control, making it impossible to fulfil any of the obligations provided for in these Regulations, not resulting from the Organizer's fault or negligence, and remaining insurmountable despite the exercise of all due care, in particular: events of the nature of natural disasters such as floods, hurricanes, windstorms of extraordinary strength, whirlwinds, earthquakes, exceptionally intense and prolonged downpours or extraordinary and external events that could not have been prevented (such as war, martial law restrictions, insurrection, revolution, riots, terrorist attack), epidemic threats, states of epidemic danger, epidemics and states of epidemics, as well as new legal acts or decisions of administrative authorities preventing the Organizer from fulfilling its obligations. Neither the Organizer nor the competitors shall be liable for failure to perform or improper performance of the provisions of these Regulations caused by force majeure.

IV. DATE AND PLACE

- 4.1. The event will take place on August 5, 2023 in Gdynia.
- 4.2. Start and Finish will be located on the City Beach in Gdynia.
- 4.3. The start time of the event will be published in the "Event Schedulet" on the event website at a later date.
- 4.4. The organizer reserves the right to change the location of the start and finish line.

V. DISTANCE, ROUTE, TIME LIMT

- 5.1. The race will be held at the distance of 750 m of the swimming stage, 20,6 km of the cycling stage and 5 km of the running stage.
- 5.2. Swimming at the distance of 750 m. The start will take place in the Rolling Start formula from the shoreline of the City Beach in Gdynia. Expected water temperature: 17 - 21 ° C. For safety reasons, it is obligatory to swim in neoprene and triathlon wetsuits during the race. At water temperatures below 15,9 degrees

- Celsius, long-sleeved wetsuits will be required. For water temperatures above 22 degrees Celsius, wetsuits are prohibited.
- 5.3. Cycling on a distance of 20,6 km. Traffic is closed on the entire route. Convention competition without drafting! All types of bicycles in good technical condition are allowed.
 - 5.4. Running a distance of 5 km
 - 5.5. The Organizer reserves that the final length of the routes of particular stages may slightly differ from the lengths given in points 5.1., 5.2., 5.3. and 5.4. Permissible difference is +/- 10% for each stage and the exact length of the routes will be given after their final approval and will be included in GPX files of the routes made available by the Organizer.
 - 5.6. Time limits:
 - 5.6.1. Swim: 30 minutes
 - 5.6.2. Swim and bike: 1 hours 30 minute
 - 5.6.3. Swim, bike and run: 2 hours
 - 5.7. The time limit for the completion of the individual sections of the cycling and running route of the Event will be published on the website of the Event no later than 14 days before the Event.
 - 5.8. The detailed route of the event will be published on the event website. The Organizer has the right to change the route and its distance. Such a change shall not give rise to any additional claims and obligations.
 - 5.9. Apart from the Organizer, persons authorised by the Organizer and public services, no person without a start number is allowed on the route. Persons violating this prohibition may be removed from the route by appropriate services.
 - 5.10. Electronic time measurement control points will be located on the route of the race. Omitting the control gate may result in disqualification.
 - 5.11. On the route of the Event there will be a nutrition point (running stage).
 - 5.12. After the limit expires, the athlete is obliged to immediately leave the race route.
 - 5.13. A person who stays on the route after the time has expired, does so at his own risk and may be punished for breaking traffic regulations and the Civil Code.

VI. PARTICIPATION

- 6.1. A person who is 16 years of age at the day of the race (person born before August 5, 2007) may participate in the event.
- 6.2. Each athlete must be verified at the Race Office.
- 6.3. Successful verification is conditional upon the team captain or team member appearing in person and submitting to the race office proof of confirmation of a QR ticket and identity card or passport, and photocopies of the identity card or passport of the absent team members.
- 6.4. The QR ticket, necessary for verification at the race office, will be made available to the athlete no later than 3 days before the event to the e-mail address provided during registration.
- 6.5. The athlete starting in a cycling stage is obliged to leave his/her bike in the Transition Zone the day before the Event and to collect his/her bike from the Transition Zone after the Event.
- 6.6. The cost of the entry fee, accommodation, travel and own meals are covered by the athlete on his own.

- 6.7. The relay consists of three riders, of which:
 - 6.7.1. the first rider sails 750 m and reaches the transition zone
 - 6.7.2. the second rider rides a bike 20,6 km and reaches the transition zone,
 - 6.7.3. the third rider runs 5 km and finishes the distance at the finish line
- 6.8. One relay participant can only compete in one stage of the Event.
- 6.9. For safety reasons it is prohibited to:
 - 6.9.1. Bring onto the route of the Event objects that may constitute a danger to other athletes.
 - 6.9.2. To participate in the event wearing clothing which covers the face and makes it impossible to identify the athlete.
 - 6.9.3. Start with animals.
 - 6.9.4. Start with pushchairs
- 6.10. An athlete, taking part in the swimming stage, is obliged to participate in the event wearing the cap provided in the start package. An athlete taking part in the cycling stage is obliged to place the starting number while cycling under the saddle and on the cycling helmet; it is recommended to place the starting number on the back while cycling due to the chip placed on the back of the number. The athlete, competing in the cross-country stage, is required to place the starting number on the front at waist height under penalty of disqualification.
- 6.11. The change of athletes is made by a tap of the hand of the athlete starting a stage of the event by the athlete finishing in a stage of the event at a place in the Transition Zone designated by the organizer.

VII. SAFETY

- 7.1. By stepping on the starting line the athlete acknowledges that he/she is taking part solely at his/her own responsibility, and in the case of minors at the responsibility of their parents or legal guardians. The competitor, parent or legal guardian in the case of minors assumes the risk involved, acknowledging that participation in the competition involves physical exertion and involves the natural risk and danger of accidents, the possibility of personal injury and physical trauma (including death) as well as damage and loss of a property nature and has voluntarily decided to assume this risk. The above does not exclude the organizer's liability resulting from mandatory legal regulations.
- 7.2. The organizer provides accident insurance to athletes who have been correctly verified in the Race Office. Each athlete will be covered by insurance cover in the field of accident insurance occurring during the insurer's liability period in the territory of the Republic of Poland, consisting in bodily injury or health disorder, causing permanent health impairment or death of the insured. The insurance is paid by the Policyholder, ie the Organizer.
- 7.3. The athletes are obliged to strictly follow the instructions of the Organizers, services responsible for road traffic management, including the Police, Municipal Police, judges and other services securing the route of the event.
- 7.4. The decisions of the medical service regarding the continuation of the race by athletes are final and indisputable. The medical transport of the athlete results in his disqualification.
- 7.5. If an athlete decides to withdraw from the competition at any time during the event, he/she must notify the judges or the organizer.

VIII. REGISTRATION

- 8.1. Registration for the Event will take place via the registration form available on SlotMarket.pl from October 25, 2022 to July 30, 2023 or until places are sold out.
- 8.2. The limit of athletes in the event is 150 teams. If the limit is reached, the Organizer reserves the right to close the registration earlier.
- 8.3. The Organizer reserves the right to invite people to take part in the Event after the limit of places has been reached or after the date given in point 8.1.
- 8.4. The organizer reserves the right to change the limit of places, and everyone who has purchased the package by the date of announcement of such a change has a guaranteed right to start.
- 8.5. The registration is considered when the application form is correctly completed and when the payment of the entry fee is paid in the amount specified in these regulations.
- 8.6. The confirmation of successful registration is:
 - 8.6.1. confirmation of registration for the event from SlotMarket.pl (confirmation from the email address contact@slotmarket.pl);
 - 8.6.2. payment confirmation from DotPay (confirmation from email address transakcje@dotpay.pl);
 - 8.6.3. information about registration in the Registration History on the SlotMarket.pl in user account (status: "Registered").
- 8.7. Team members must register by June 3, 2023. After this date, registration will be available at the Race Office, during opening hours

IX. GROUP REGISTRATION

- 9.1. Group registrations are accepted via the email address faktury@slotmarket.pl.
- 9.2. Payment for group entries is made to the Organizer's bank account on the basis of a Pro-Forma document with a 7-day payment deadline. Pro-Forma document is issued for the start of at least three participants (it is not possible to receive Pro-Forma for the start of a group of up to two people and for individual start).
- 9.3. Group registrations are accepted up to 30 days before closing the registration form.
- 9.4. In order to receive a Pro-Forma document, please send: invoice details and the number of participants to the address faktury@slotmarket.pl.
- 9.5. After making the payment for the Pro-Forma document, registration codes will be sent, reducing the entry fee.
- 9.6. Registration codes are valid for 14 days from the date of receipt of the codes.
- 9.7. People who register using codes are required to fill in the event registration form available on the SlotMarket.pl website and provide the code in the last step of registration.
- 9.8. People who do not register using the code, will not be allowed to take part in the Event.

X. ENTRY FEE

- 10.1.1. The current entry fee for the Event can be found at www.SloMarket.pl on the Event registration form.
- 10.2. The entry fee should be paid via the DotPay transaction service. All data provided in payments are entered on a secure encrypted page.

- 10.3. The fee must be paid upon registration, otherwise the application will be canceled.
- 10.4. The Entry Fee consists of servicing the athlete before the event (e-mail communication and via Social Media channels), maintaining the servers of the event website, purchases and renting products necessary to organize the event, as well as organizing and promoting the event.
- 10.5. An athlete who wants to receive an invoice for the paid entry fee should select the appropriate option in the registration form and enter the required data needed to issue the document. The invoice will be generated automatically after the payment is credited and will be available for download from the athlete's profile.
- 10.6. The organizer does not issue invoices in paper form.
- 10.7. The invoice may be requested by writing to the address fakture@slotmarket.pl until the end of the event.
- 10.8. Invoices to the individual will be issued up to three months after payment.
- 10.9. Business invoices will be issued by the fifteenth of the month following payment.

XI. STARTING KIT

- 11.1. As part of the event, each athlete receives:
 - 11.1.1. Bib number
 - 11.1.2. Set of stickers
 - 11.1.3. Swim cap
 - 11.1.4. Wristband
 - 11.1.5. Deposit bag
 - 11.1.6. Chip
- 11.2. Athletes who have completed the event are entitled to get a medal and a finisher t-shirt.
- 11.3. The size of the T-shirt must be provided during registration. T-shirt size can be changed up to 45 days before the event.
- 11.4. The starting package will be collected by scanning the QR code at the race office and verifying the data on the basis of an identity document (team captain and team members).
- 11.5. Each member of the relay is required to wear an wristband, which is included in the starting kit.
- 11.6. An athlete who transfers participation in the Event to another person and a person who participates in the Event without notifying the Organizer may be disqualified, as well as suspended from participation in events organized by Sport Evolution Group Sp. z o.o. for 2 years.
- 11.7. A competitor taking part in a cycling stage is obliged to bring and collect his/her bike to/from the Changing Zone on his/her own.
- 11.8. The starting kit, which will not be collected during the working hours of the Race Office may be sent to the Athlete by courier on his/her request to the following address: gdynia@ironman.com within 7 days from the day of the Event. The cost of delivery is:
 - 11.8.1. 50 PLN – Poland
 - 11.8.2. 25 EUR - European Union countries
 - 11.8.3. 70 EUR- countries outside the European Union
- 11.9. The cost of delivery is paid by the Athlete before delivery.

XII. RACE OFFICE, TRANSITION ZONE, START, FINISH

RACE OFFICE

- 12.1. The race office will be located at Kościuszki square in Gdynia, August 5, 2023.
- 12.2. The race office will be open from 12:00 p.m. - 21:00 p.m. (August 4, 2023).
- 12.3. The Race Office will be closed on the day of the event.
- 12.4. Each athlete is obliged to pick up his/her starting kit at the Race Office during its opening hours. Starting kits will not be given to another person.
- 12.5. The opening hours of the Race Office and location are possible to change. Such change shall not give rise to any additional claims and liabilities. The exact opening hours of the Race Office and its location will be published on www.ironmangdynia.pl and on www.ironman.com.

TRANSITION ZONE

- 12.6. The Transition Zone will be located at Kościuszki square in Gdynia:
- 12.7. Transition Zone will be open:
 - 12.7.1. Check-in bike, August 4, 2023 from 15:00 p.m. to 21:30 p.m.
 - 12.7.2. Checking of bikes and leaving bidons, August 5 2023 from 6:00 a.m. to 7:30 a.m.
 - 12.7.3. Check-out of bike, August 5, 2023 from 13:00 p.m. - 15:00 p.m.
- 12.8. Only athletes who have a wristband (put on at the Race Office), a chip, a taped helmet, a taped bike and taped Transition Bags can enter the Transition Zones.
- 12.9. Before entering the Transition Zone the technical condition of the bicycle will be checked by the Event Judge. Bicycles that do not meet the requirements described in 5.3. or endanger the safety of the Athlete or others will not be allowed into the Event.
- 12.10. Each Athlete, competing in the cycling stage, is obliged to introduce his/her bike on August 4, 2023.
- 12.11. August 5, 2023 it will not be possible to check-in bike in the Transition Zone. On August 5, 2023 in Transition Zones it will only be possible to check the bike, inflate the wheels and bring in bidons.
- 12.12. Check-out bike and Transition Bags on August 5, 2023 at the times stated in point 12.7.3. with BIB number, chip and wristband.
- 12.13. The opening hours of Transition Zones and location are possible to change. Such change shall not give rise to any additional claims and liabilities. The exact opening hours of Transition Zones and its location will be published on www.ironmangdynia.pl and on www.ironman.com.

START & FINISH

- 12.14. The start and finish line will be located on the city beach in Gdynia.
- 12.15. Rolling start, 8 people every 10 seconds.
- 12.16. The start time will be published at www.ironmangdynia.pl and at www.ironman.com.
- 12.17. The organizer reserves the right to change the organization of the start.
- 12.18. The athlete competing in the swimming stage is obliged to wear the swimming cap which he/she received in the starting kit at the race office..
- 12.19. Only athletes who have crossed the finish line may be present at the finish line. After crossing the finish line the athlete will receive a commemorative medal.

- 12.20. It is forbidden to run into the finish line with an accompanying person, animal or things which may endanger the safety of the athlete or other people. Failure to comply with this point will result in disqualification
- 12.21. The finish line may only be crossed by an athlete participating in the cross-country stage, if another team member crosses the finish line, the team will be disqualified.

XIII. EXTRA SERVICES

- 13.1. During registration for the event and after its completed, the athlete may purchase Extra Services.
- 13.2. The purchase of Extra Services is not obligatory and is not necessary to complete the race. The purchase of Extra Services is possible up to 7 days before the date of the race.
- 13.3. The price for the Extra Services is given in the event registration form on the Slotmarket.pl website.
- 13.4. The Organizer is not responsible for the quality and timing of additional services. All complaints should be submitted to the entity providing the purchased service.
- 13.5. Fees for additional extra services through Slotmarket.pl are refunded until June 21, 2023.

XIV. WITHDRAWALS & TRANSFERS

- 14.1. It is not possible to transfer the paid entry fee to another year or another event.
- 14.2. Withdrawal from the event should be reported via [the form](#). The amount of the refund of the entry fee depends on the date of registration:
 - 14.2.1. until May 5, 2023 we refund: 50% of the entry fee;
 - 14.2.2. from May 6, 2023 until July 5, 2023, we refund: 25% of the entry fee;
 - 14.2.3. from July 6, 2023, the entry fee is not refunded.
- 14.3. If additional purchases (e.g. medal engraving or FinisherPix) have been purchased along with the original race entry, it cannot be transferred to the new race. Additional purchases will be refunded until 45 days prior to the race and will need to be repurchased by the athlete.
- 14.4. The organizer allows changing Team Captains and Team Members up to 7 days before the Event. After this date it will not be possible to change Team Captains and Team Members. To make a change, please email gdynia@ironman.com
- 14.5. Starting kits purchased in full or in part with a voucher or discount code are not refundable, transferable to another event or deferrable.

XV. CLASSIFICATIONS & PRIZES

- 15.1. The following classifications will be held as part of the race:
 - 15.1.1. Men's classification (men's teams only)
 - 15.1.2. Women's classification (women's teams only)
 - 15.1.3. Mixed classification (teams of one woman and two men or two women and one man)
- 15.2. The official time of the event is the gross time of the team.

- 15.3. The results will be announced no later than 15 minutes before the awards ceremony. The results will be hosted on the website www.wyniki.datasport.pl.
- 15.4. The results will be published on the event website and delivered to the media.
- 15.5. The winners of places 1-3 in the age groups of women and men will receive souvenir trophies.
- 15.6. In the case of absence from the award ceremony, the prizes can only be collected at the Organizer's office up to 30 days after the end of the event.
- 15.7. The organizer reserves the right to introduce additional prizes in selected categories.

XVI. PROTECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

- 16.1. Personal data controller of participants is Sport Evolution Group Sp. z o.o., Jana Kochanowskiego street 12/23, 01-864 Warsaw, daneosobowe@sporteolution.pl.
- 16.2. Personal data of participants of Event will be processed for the purposes of organizing and carrying out Event, to select the winner and to award, release, receive the prize and other activities related to the economic activity and will not be shared with other customers.
- 16.3. For the purposes of chip timing and result sheet creation as well as sending one's bib number information and official time, personal data of the athlete (name, last name, year of birth, gender, city, email address, phone number) will be shared with Datasport, ul. Okrężna 22, 58-310 Szczawno Zdrój.
- 16.4. The participant has a right to access his/her data and correct them. Providing personal data and consent to their processing is optional, but necessary to achieve the said objectives. Failure to provide data or lack of consent to their processing prevents participation in the event. Please be advised that your consent may be revoked at any time.
- 16.5. Processing of participants data, in connection with participation in the event, includes publication of name, surname, year of birth, club participant with the name of the town in which he resides - in every way in which the project will be published.
- 16.6. All information concerning participants obtained by the Organizer and included in the registration form will be recorded in electronic way and in each case they will be used pursuant to in accordance with the applicable law.
- 16.7. The organizer reserves the right to carry out interviews with each of the participants, take photos and film them for advertising, promotional purposes, use on the Internet or in radio and TV broadcasts and for other commercial purposes.
- 16.8. The Organizer reserves the right to use, without compensation, all photographs, films, interviews, and voice recordings introducing the Event participants. These materials may be used by the Organizer in the form of CD-ROMs, DVDs, catalogues, internet sites, newspapers, and exhibition stands, as well for promotional-commercial purposes concerning the Events run by the organizers.
- 16.9. The data retention period shall be
 - 16.9.1. For data processed for the purpose of asserting possible legal claims - until the claim is time-barred or the proceedings related to the claim are concluded.

- 16.9.2. For data processed for the purpose of documenting and communicating activities, not more than 5 years from the date of the documented event, unless the data are processed for archiving purposes in the public interest.
- 16.9.3. For data processed to ensure the security of networks and information systems - not more than 5 years from the date of registration.
- 16.9.4. For data processed on the basis of the athlete's agreement - until that agreement is withdrawn.
- 16.10. In order to withdraw your consent to the processing of your personal data, you must complete the application form on <https://slotmarket.pl/document/polityka-prywatnosci> and send it to contact@slotmarket.pl.

XVII. COMPLAINTS

- 17.1. Complaints concerning matters related to the Event shall be submitted in writing with justification to the Organizer's correspondence address, with the note "Sprint Triathlon Gdynia Relay - Complaint", within 7 days from the date of the event - directly or by registered mail (the date of the postmark is decisive) or to the address: gdynia@ironman.com, with the note "Sprint Triathlon Gdynia Relay - Complaint".
- 17.2. Complaints sent after the deadline in point 17.1. will not be considered.
- 17.3. Complaints about race will be considered by Organizer within 60 days of their receipt.
- 17.4. The Organizer's decision on complaints about race will be final.
- 17.5. The above does not limit the Consumer's rights to pursue their claims under mandatory provisions of law before common courts.

XVIII. COMPLAINTS PROCEDURE

- 18.1. All Event participants are bound by these Regulations.
- 18.2. The Rules shall apply from the date of their publication i.e. October 25, 2022.
- 18.3. Each participant is obliged to read the regulations.
- 18.4. Ignorance of the Regulations does not release the athlete from the rules specified by the Organizer in these Regulations.
- 18.5. It is forbidden to bring any kind of narcotic, illegal substance, drugs improving athletic performance, as well as alcoholic products to the area encompassing the Event. Participants are prohibited from taking such drugs and substances both before and during the race, failure to abide by this rule may result in exclusion from participation in the Event. If it is found that an athlete violates the above prohibition, the organizer reserves the right not to allow him to participate in the race or exclude him during the race.
- 18.6. No athlete may use performance enhancing drugs or activities. Competitors may be required to undergo pre- and post-competition testing. If an athlete is called for a test, they are required to attend the test.
- 18.7. On the reverse of the bib number there will be a table that each athlete should fill in for easier identification in the case of an accident. The table contains data on

the medications taken, possible allergies and the telephone number of the person to be contacted by the Organizer in the case of an accident.

- 18.8. The organizer provides emergency medical care along the route and at the finish line.
- 18.9. The event Organizer provides safety in the water during the race (through WOPR).
- 18.10. The Organizer shall provide a deposit. Valuables cannot be left in the deposit, but only things necessary for basic needs both before and after the Event
- 18.11. The Organizer is not responsible for lost valuables during the Event.
- 18.12. The organizer takes responsibility only for equipment left in the Transition Zone which is necessary to complete the race, i.e.: bicycle, helmet, shoes, wetsuit. Additional equipment (watches, bicycle computers, goggles, etc.) are left in the Transition Zone at the athlete's own risk.
- 18.13. In case of theft or damage to equipment, each athlete is obliged to report this fact to the Organizer representative in the Transition zone and the police. Entries will be accepted by the Organizer only until it receives the equipment and leave the Transition zone by an athlete.
- 18.14. The organizer reserves the right to cancel or modify the event without giving reasons. If it is not possible to conduct a swimming competition (red flag), the swimming will be canceled or a 1,1 km run will be organized.
- 18.15. The event will take place regardless of weather conditions.
- 18.16. The organizer has the right to change the rules contained in the regulations provided that all participants are informed of these changes in writing or during the technical briefing before the start.
- 18.17. Absence of technical check doesn't exempt the athlete from complying with these Regulations on this check-in.
- 18.18. Only the organizer of the event is entitled to a binding and final interpretation of the regulations of these regulations. If any of the provisions of the Regulations is partially or entirely changed - all other provisions remain valid.
- 18.19. The organizer reserves the right to change the name of the event
- 18.20. In matters not covered by the regulations, the Organizer shall decide on the basis of the applicable law. The above does not limit the right to court in case of a dispute.
